#### 讲座摘要：

当前由部分藏人及其支持者的示威以及由此引发的暴力冲突事件，不仅引起全球的广泛关注，也导致全世界华人的空前团结。这次不幸事件的历史以及意识/宗教根源在哪里？重要的是，这对中国长期以来寻求的和平发展和稳定性有何影响？特别是在当今全球化的同时，这将如何影响中国的对外关系和国际形象？西藏问题该如何处理？黄靖博士会在这次讲座中分析讨论中国的西藏政策以及达赖及其流亡集团的动态。

#### 主讲者简介：

黄靖博士，东亚研究所高级访问研究员，于1994年在美国哈佛大学获得博士学位，主修政治。他发表了多篇学术论文和学术著作，他的研究兴趣包括中国政治（精英政治和领导关系，军队和政治角色，国防问题以及外交政策），亚太地区国际关系（中美关系，台湾和韩国安全问题）以及东亚及中国研究东亚的政治经济体系。

**Talk abstract:**

The recent demonstrations by the Tibetans and their supporters, which quickly escalated into violent confrontations, in and outside China have drawn world-wide attention on the one hand, and caused an unprecedented solidarity among the Chinese all over the world on the other hand. What are the historical and ideological/religious roots of this unfortunate event? And more importantly, what is the impact on China's long-term development and stability, especially her foreign relations and image which are salient for China's continuous "peaceful development" in the age of globalization? Are there any solutions to this issue? Dr. Huang Jing, a visiting senior research fellow at EAI, will share his view on these questions and his assessment of China's Tibet policy and approach to the Dalai Lama and the Tibetan exile community.

### About speaker:

**Dr Huang Jing** is currently a visiting senior research fellow at the East Asian Institute (EAI) of the National University of Singapore. Before joining EAI, he was a Senior Fellow at the John Thornton China Center at the Brookings Institution. Dr. Huang received his Ph.D. in Government from Harvard University; M.A. in History from Fudan University; and B.A. in English Literature from Sichuan University. He has published numerous articles and book chapters on Chinese politics, China's development strategy, foreign policy, the military and its political role in China, US-China relations, and security issues in the Asian Pacific region.
