Development in Youth Wing

The Sub-Committee of Youth Wing recently had a meeting on its development. It has been decided that the following members will be providing their assistance in the respective areas:

1. Dr Lee Cheng Keng – Arts and Culture

Dr Lee Cheng Keng is the Head of Department (Theatre) in Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts. He graduated from the National University of Singapore with MA and BA (Hon) (1st Class) in Japanese Studies. He was a recipient of NUS Research Scholarship, Sanwa Bank Foundation Postgraduate Award, and Tan Kah Kee Scholar Postgraduate Scholarship in 2000. Dr Lee further pursued his academic research in China on the Chinese Government Scholarship and NAC Overseas Bursary from 2003 to 2006. He studied at the Department of Directing with Prof Xu Xiaozhong, one of the most important directors in modern China theatre, and attained his PhD from the Central Academy of Drama in Beijing last year. Dr Lee was also awarded the Mitsui Toatsu book prize and gold medal for Japanese Studies in 1999 and a Japanese Government Scholarship for Japanese Culture and Language in 1996.

Effectively bilingual, Dr Lee has published in both English and Chinese. He regularly contributes articles on theatre, cultural and social issues related to China and Singapore to the *Lian He Zao Bao* and *The Strait Times*. He was co-editor (with C.J. Wee Wan Ling) of "Two Plays by Kuo Pao Kun" published in 2002.

2. Ms Dong Xu – Liaison in Key Universities of China

Ms Dong Xu is the Manager of In-Sense Technologies Pte Ltd. She graduated from Shanghai Jiaotong University and is currently the Assistant Secretary of the Shanghai Jiaotong University Alumni Association (Singapore). She will assist in liaison with the

key universities of China.

In addition, representatives of the National University of Singapore and Nanyang Technological University will be providing assistance to the Youth Wing of SCFA.
